

MacQueen Bursary 2024

The CPHVA Education and Development Trust is pleased to announce the MacQueen Bursaries for 2024. Applications are welcome from Health Visitors, School Nurses, Community Nursery Nurses, and other members of Community Public Health Nursing Teams.

What can I use a MacQueen Bursary for?

Applications are invited to fund any of the following activities:

- **Practice development initiatives** to facilitate the health and wellbeing of individuals, families, groups, or communities.
- A **research project** focused on the enhancement of practice in community settings.
- Engagement in **professional or academic study** activities to enhance the applicant's practice.

What are the application criteria?

All applications must meet the following criteria:

- Applicants must be current members of UNITE/CPHVA.
- Applicants will need to state the **total amount they are seeking** and should include a **detailed costing for the project** or study activity. Priority will be given to the shortlisted applications that demonstrate the greatest potential to enhance practice.

Note: Bursaries can only be awarded to the individual and not an employing organisation.

How do I apply?

We will be **accepting applications twice throughout the year** (1^{st} January – 29^{th} February 2024, and later in the year, 1^{st} September – 31^{st} October 2024)

- Shortlisted applicants will be assessed by an online interview to take place following the closing dates for applications.
